Sheriffs Departments:

- ❖ Most Sheriffs locations charge \$10/person as the non-profit rate. The Cupertino location charges \$15/person. Prices may have changed – please check with the local office. Please mention / remind them that this is for a non-profit.
- ❖ Please have your coach's and assistant coach's turn in their receipts to you. We may need to refer to these at a later time.
- ❖ It is recommended that all applicants make an appointment first. Please see the Sheriffs Web Site to make an appointment: <http://www.sccsheriff.org>

Tracking Number: After scheduling your appointment you will most likely receive a tracking number. Please remember this number for when you go in for your appointment – it makes it easier to locate your information on the computer

- **Other items:** When scheduling an appointment on-line, please do not use any periods (.) in the "Agency authorized to receive criminal history information" or in the "Street or PO Box" address field. Please remember to select the "DOJ - yes" radio button field under level of service.

Some of the important things to remember when appearing at the Sheriff's Department's for the Finger Printing Process:

1. **Make an appointment for prompt service** – use the convenient [APPLICANT WEBSITE](https://sheriff.livescan.sccsheriff.org/sfpnew/FingerPrintApplication.jsp) (<https://sheriff.livescan.sccsheriff.org/sfpnew/FingerPrintApplication.jsp>) to secure your personal appointment. Please be prompt. If you are late you may have to reschedule or WAIT for the next available opening. **Walk-in applicants are not recommended** and must wait for an available opening.
 - Those volunteers who do not have access to the internet may make an appointment by phone at one of the locations
 - Missed appointments may be assessed a fee equal to the local fee charged for each applicant.
2. Bring the "**Request for live scan service form**" and a copy of your [APPLICANT WEBSITE](#) printout.
3. **No children please.** Applicants need to make arrangements for child care prior to being fingerprinted.
4. **Valid photographic I.D. MUST be presented at time of service:**
Acceptable forms of I.D. are:
 - 1) Driver's License.
 - 2) California Identification Card.
 - 3) Military I.D.
 - 4) Passport.**A second I.D. of any type should also be brought.**
5. **Fingernails:**
Extremely long or curved fingernails may prevent the fingers from properly contacting the printing platen and may need trimming.
6. **Bandaged or injured fingers:**
Applicant may need to reschedule their appointment until the injured or bandaged finger can be fingerprinted.
7. Free parking is available.
8. The service is provided during hours specified at the site locations.
9. Applicants or volunteers with nonprofit organizations will be charged at least a \$10.00 local fingerprinting fee. The fees are subject to change without notice.

Acceptable forms of payment:

- 1) Travelers checks
- 2) Cashiers checks or Money orders
- 3) Cash (exact amount)

NO CREDIT CARDS - PLEASE.

10. All prints are taken electronically and transmitted -- NO hard copy will be supplied.
