



Silicon Valley NJB Section All-Net League Tryout Process

Players are allowed to play in ONLY one (1) NJB League: either Division or All-Net.

This document is to be followed by all players desiring to play in the Silicon Valley NJB All-Net Program.

1. Players **MUST** tryout in their Local Home Chapter. If a player is unable to attend their Local Chapter's All-Net tryouts, that player **MUST** play in the Local Home Chapter's Division League if the player still wants to play NJB basketball. A Local Chapter can place a Local player on their All-Net team without a formal tryout.
2. A player cannot be placed on a Non-Local Chapter's All-Net team without the player first trying out for their Local Home Chapter's All-Net team.
3. If a player do not make their Local Chapter's All-Net team, the player **MAY**:
 - Tryout with the next nearest Non-Local Chapter - if tryouts are still available
 - Request a guaranteed slot (**signed up and not on a waiting list**) to play in their Local Chapter's Division League if the player do not make an All-Net team in a Non-Local Chapter – player **MUST** play Division League in their Local Chapter
4. Players trying for a Non-Local Chapter All-Net team, **MUST** receive a "Non-Local Chapter All-Net Tryout Form" from their Local Home Chapter. All fields on this form must be completed. The Local Chapter will log and track all Local players trying out at Non-Local Chapters.
5. The player **MUST** present the completed "Non-Local Chapter All-Net Tryout Form" to the Non-Local Chapter prior to attending and participating in their tryouts. If the player does not have a completed signed form, that player shall not be allowed to try out in a "Non-Local Chapter.
6. If the Local player makes the Non-Local Chapter team, the player **MUST** obtain a "Player Waiver/Release Form" from the player's Local Home Chapter.
7. Any player playing on a Non-Local Chapter team, **MUST** include a copies of the "Non-Local Chapter All-Net Tryout Form" and the "Player Waiver/Release Form" with the players certification documents in the All-Net Team Certification Binder.
8. If player does not make a Non-Local Chapter All-Net team and still wants to play in the Divisional NJB league, the player **MUST** play Division League in their Local Home Chapter.
9. Any player trying out for All-Net team outside their Local Home chapter should request that their Local Home Chapter reserve a guaranteed slot (**signed up and not on a waiting list**) in the Local Chapter's Division League. This request must be made prior to receiving a "Non-Local Chapter All-Net Tryout Form" from the Local Chapter.
10. A team with a minimum of seven (7) players, within a Chapter's boundaries, will be allowed a maximum of one (1) player that resides outside the chapter's boundaries. A team with eight (8) or more players shall be allowed a maximum of two (2) non-Local waiver players by way of the "All-Net Tryout Process":
 - Grandfathered waivers are not included in the two (2) non-Local waivers
11. The two (2) non-Local waiver players **MUST** have tried out for their Local Home Chapter's All-Net team first.
12. No future rights or privileges are afforded Non-Local 1 Year waiver players beyond the 1 year.
13. **Players found to have by-passed the "All-Net Tryout Process" as defined above will be allowed to finish the regular season, but will be declared ineligible for any and all post season play.**
