Teams will play against All-Net teams in the National tournament - lower bracket. |
| PLAYERS: | All players must have played a minimum of five (5) games during the regular season. A maximum of ten (10) players per team. | |
| AWARDS: | Individual awards will be given to 1 st and 2 nd Place team members. | |
| PROTESTS: | NJB does not recognize or allow protests during the All-Star Tournaments, except for Player Participation violations. Player Participation violations can be protested and must be entered in the official/League scorebook before the end of the game and the Gym Monitor or Chapter Director MUST notify the Silicon Valley NJB Tournament Director, Andre Hunt, immediately. | |

| HOME & VISITOR: | Home: Top of Bracket, light colored uniforms, sits on left bench (from the scorer table's view). Each team will take the opposite basket for warm-ups and first-half play. The head coach and assistant coach must check-in at the gate before each game. Visitor: Bottom of Bracket, dark uniforms, sits on right bench (from the score table's view). | |
| BENCH PERSONNEL: | A maximum of one head and one assistant coach are allowed on the bench. A TEAM SCOREKEEPER may sit at the end of the bench. Only Team personnel may sit on the Bench. Only 2 Bench Personnel will be admitted into the gym at no charge. | |
| TEAM SCOREKEEPER: | The team scorekeeper must sit at the end of the bench. The team scorekeeper will have access to the OFFICIAL scorekeeper at the end of the Periods and at Half time ONLY. No exceptions unless directed by the Referee. Team Score keepers MUST NOT disturb the League/Official score and time keepers. | |
